Rob Smith Demonstration on making a Segmented Turning

Segmented Turning By Rod Smith

Rod Smith provided a demo and all the steps required to turn a segmented bowl. He provided different types of design and planning software that is available on the market as well as designing and planning by manual methods. He explained that turning a segmented bowl is not a fast process and that you need patience and unobstructed time to achieve a segmented piece. He stressed that most important step in turning a segmented project is the design phase and unlike to turning a bowl you have to make the design choices before you start. Once your design has been finished then you have to determine how tall and what diameter your project will be and many segments per ring you are going to use before laying out your design on graph paper to determine your cut sheet and amount of wood that will be needed for the project. The demo was very well presented and a number of questions were asked that added to the demo. Good job Rod on this demo.
