Rod Smith showed how to turn a Norfolk Pine Vessel outside shape. He talked about aligning the blank on the lathe between centers to get the best grain orientation and the best final completed Vessel. He then rough turned the outside and cut his tenon for mounting in his chuck. Once in the chuck he could proceed with getting the outside shape of the Vessel while still using tailstock support. Due to time running out he will finish the Vessel at home and bring it back for Show and Tell. Good Job Rod.
